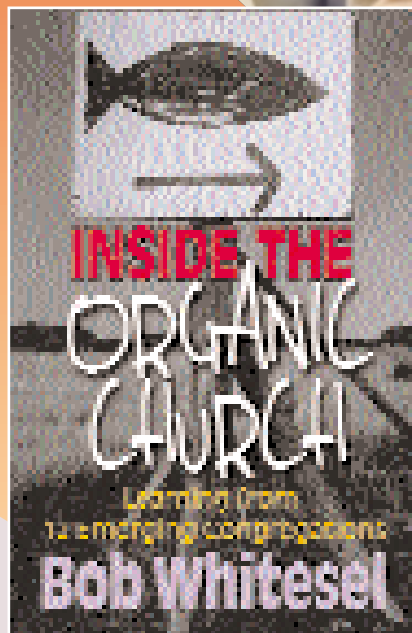


Go BIG: Lead Your Church to Explosive Growth,

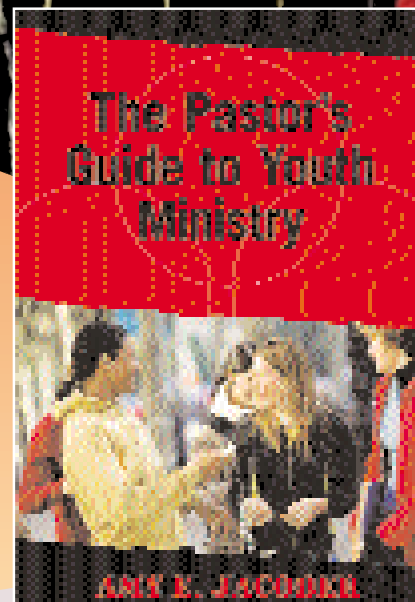


Inside the Organic Church: Learning from 12 Emerging Congregations,
