~2010 RALPH GARFIELD SCHELL PRESIDENT'S AWARD

The Rev. Mildred "Millie" Myren has received the 2010 Ministers Council Ralph Garfield Schell President's Award for Excellence in the Ministry. The award was announced by Ministers Council President Jeff Savage at the Ministers Council Senate concluding banquet on August 18. She was nominated by the President of the Metro Chicago Ministers Council, Rev. Carol Jamieson Brown.

The President's Award was instituted in 1996 as the recognition of a member of a local Ministers Council who seems to be extraordinarily faithful in carrying out the principles of the Ministers Council Code of Ethics, as well as unusually effective in fulfilling the objectives of the five committees of our structure..." The award is announced annually, and usually at the closing banquet of the American Baptist Ministers Council Senate.

The Rev. Millie Myren grew up in the Morgan Park Baptist Church of Chicago where her father was the music director for 59 years. In 1978 she became an administrator in what was then called the Chicago Baptist Association, now ABC Metro Chicago and was named Interim Executive Minister serving from 1988-89 and again in 1993. In 1994 Millie was named Executive Minister of the Region.
